The Emergency Medical Technician course is a 200-hour program for those interested in the field of Emergency Medical Services. This course is required for individuals volunteering on an ambulance squad or seeking a career in the Emergency Medical Services. PCCC is accredited by the New Jersey State Department of Health, Office of Emergency Medical Services as meeting the requirements of N.J.A.C. 8:40A as an approved EMT Training Site. Upon successful completion of the program, participants are eligible to take the certification examination for Emergency Medical Technician administered by the New Jersey State Department of Health.

***\*Prerequisites:***

- *Proof of Tuberculosis (PPD) Testing are required within the first 14 days of class*
- *Students over 18 years old must provide a Background check from their local Police Department (Fingerprints are not required)*
- *Student must have fluency in English - both spoken and written.*
- *Students must purchase a stethoscope prior to class*
